6:15pm Report to JCA dressing room in traditional uniforms. (ALL "full uniform" rules still apply! Please

no jewelry, nail polish or heavy/brightly colored makeup, hair ties, etc.) Bring a water bottle -

you will want water after the first concert!

6:30 Concert #1 - 6th grade/Marching Band

7:20ish Concert #1 concludes. Get cases, water bottles etc. from dressing room. (Battery leave your

instruments in the scene shop.) You will move as a group over to the JH Cafeteria. Feel free to bring study materials for the down time between performances. All students must remain in the

JH cafeteria.

8:15 Concert #2 - 7th & 8th Grade Bands/Marching Band

8:30 Move as a group back to the JCA dressing room. (Leave cases in the JH Cafeteria.) We will do a

very brief warmup before our second performance.

9:15ish Concert #2 concludes. Horn line return to JH Cafeteria for cases etc. Tubas, Battery and Color

Guard bring instruments/equipment back to the HS band room. Front Ensemble will move all

equipment to the dressing rooms, then return it to the stadium/garage Friday morning.

7:30 Arrive at Grand Ledge High School. Chaperones and bus drivers need to get their hands stamped; equipment crew members who will be going on the field need a wristband. Use restrooms, get instruments from buses/semi etc. Listen for instructions regarding raincoats.

8:10 Possible physical warm-up in parking lot - find staff for designated warm-up areas outside

- 8:28 Assigned warm-up (Area B) (Optional indoor warmup time 8:42-9:10 Band room/Music classroom/ Weight room)
- 9:05 Front Ensemble leave warmup
- 9:10 Warmup ends. Front Ensemble report to staging area.
- 9:20 Winds, battery and color guard report to staging area
- 9:30 PERFORMANCE

Immediately after our performance, we will retrieve raincoats wherever we left them prior to our performance. Then props, battery and front ensemble will move quickly to the semi. Battery should put drums on the semi right away. FE members should quickly break down boards for loading. Color Guard should also head to the semi to get equipment ready for loading. All horn line members will hang on to their instruments until after Awards. This must be a VERY fast loading preparation for all students heading to the semi, similar to our process after Finals in Toledo.

- 9:55 Flight II Awards (Senior Recognition and announcement of State Championships performance order only no scores or caption awards. Seniors will be on the field for recognition details TBA.)
- 10:15 Move to semi to finish loading instruments, then to buses to load for departure. You will receive a snack bag, but may bring snacks of your own if you'd like. Please do not bring any snacks which contain nuts on the buses as these may provoke allergic reactions in some of our students.
- 10:30 Leave Grand Ledge High School
- 11:45 Arrive back in Jenison and unload. Change out of costume and hang your costume on the racks.
