8:30 Rehearsal ends: load semi

9:00 Return to JHS. Line instruments in sections in the band room. (Tubas, Bari saxes and Color

Guard equipment will be unloaded by equipment parents when the semi returns.)

Saturday, November 3

You will need money for one fast food stop (lunch) for this trip.

4:25 a.m. Building open

4:45 a.m. Arrive at Jenison High School; report to auditorium for attendance. DO NOT BE LATE!!!

When told to do so, get your instruments and shako box. (Chaperones will load garment

bags.)

4:50 **Load instruments** as follows:

Flutes, Clarinets - on bus Saxes, Mellos - Bus 1 Trumpets, Baritones - Bus 2 Trombones, Tubas - Bus 3 CG equipment - Bus 4

Lay garment bags flat in the first bay of YOUR bus. Shako boxes go on the bus with you.

5:00 Leave Jenison High School.

We will NOT be stopping for food on the way to Ford Field, but the Boosters will provide a breakfast bag for you on the bus. You may certainly bring healthy food or beverages of your own but please keep the busses clean. We will stop to change into uniform on the way to Detroit. USE THE RESTROOM while we are stopped here, as restroom access once we arrive at Ford Field may be limited.

8:00 Arrive at our rented parking lot (431 Macomb St). Get your instrument/equipment ready for

warmup. Percussion head to the semi to get instruments.

8:10 Unload percussion and props in parking lot adjacent to Ford Field. Front Ensemble head to

Pit Warmup B, Battery head to Battery Warmup B. (8:40-9:10 warmup time)

8:30 Winds warmup begins in parking lot

9:05 Leave parking lot

9:15 Props and Front Ensemble report to security, then move to tunnel

9:20 All others report to security; move to tunnel and into indoor warmup with Guide

9:30-9:55 Indoor Warmup (Area B)

10:00 Report to gate and move onto field staging area

10:15 Performance

Immediately following performance, all students helping with props or moving equipment should exit the field into the Side 1 end zone/tunnel (where we entered). Make sure all Front Ensemble instruments and props are moved into the end zone or tunnel, then return to the back corner of the Side 1 end zone for the Group Photo. Color guard take equipment all the way up the stairs to put it behind the group photo area. Drum Majors should report to the tunnel for Awards immediately after our performance. The full group will remain in the photo area for the Flight II Awards Ceremony.

10:30 Flight II Awards Ceremony

11:00 Awards Ceremony concludes. Leave Ford Field together. When instructed to do so,

percussionists head to the semi (now on Adams St. in front of Comerica Park), everyone else

return to our parking lot to load instruments and equipment. Change out of uniforms on the

buses in our parking lot.

12:15 Leave Ford Field. Stop for **fast food lunch** ASAP on the way home (**\$\$\$ bring money \$\$\$**).

4:15ish Return to Jenison High School. **ALL percussionists must help unload the semi!**

Ford Field Parking Deck will cost \$6.00. It is located on St. Antoine St. across from Gate G of Ford Field. Ford Field Parking Lots #4 & 5 will also be available for use. Other parking facilities nearest to Ford Field/ Comerica Park will cost more; parking farther away from these areas may cost less. *The People Mover* runs in a loop around Detroit and has many stations near parking facilities.
