#### \*MCBA State Championships Schedule of Performances

The performance schedule for Championships will be determined after State Prelims results are posted on Oct. 28. Bands will perform in reverse order of Prelims scores (with the highest score performing last). Schedules will be posted at <a href="mailto:themcba.org">themcba.org</a> shortly after Prelims Awards on Saturday (approx. 10:30pm).

The schedule below is **tentative** until the performance order is posted by MCBA on Sunday.

• You should arrive to school in your compression gear (which may be worn under rehearsal clothes if you'd like).

· Since this is a fairly brief rehearsal, we will not unload percussion off the semi after Friday night's GVSU rehearsal. Percussionists ARE required to be at rehearsal on time. • There is a cheer camp happening in the cheer room and flex room, so we only have the turf area of the Fieldhouse. Please be respectful as we share the facility! 2:30 Rehearsal ends. Load instruments as follows: Flutes, Clarinets - on bus; Saxes, Mellos - Bus 1; Trumpets - Bus 2; Baritones - Bus 3; Tubas - Bus 4; CG equipment - Bus 5 Section leaders load spare instruments! Lay garment bags flat in the first bay of YOUR bus. Shako boxes go on the bus with you. 3:00 Load buses 3:10 Leave Jenison High School. Students may bring food for the bus ride.\* Please do not bring any snacks which contain nuts on the buses as these may provoke allergic reactions in some of our students. Fast food dinner (\$ bring money \$)\* en route to Ford Field. Change into costume. 5:00ish \*Note: Since resuming travel after Covid, we have had issues with fast food restaurants' ability to handle a group our size. We recommend that you bring a substantial snack option in case we encounter similar difficulty this year. Arrive at our rented parking lot adjacent to Ford Field (440 Madison St). Enter Ford Field 7:30 together and use restrooms. Check out the field, markings on the turf (HS and pro markings), press box area, etc! We will meet at a designated location to return to our warmup parking lot together. 8:15 Return to our rented parking lot. Get your instrument/equipment ready for warmup. Percussion get instruments from the semi. Winds & Battery begin warmup in parking lot. Front Ensemble get all equipment ready and 8:45 try to get a brief warmup in before heading to the Security Check (arrive by 9:23) 8:50 Color Guard report to Security Check on Beacon St. Gate F Color Guard enter Indoor Warmup (Area A) 9:00 9:18 Winds & Battery leave parking lot Front Ensemble and Props report to Security Check on Beacon St. Gate F 9:23 Winds & Battery report to Security Check on Beacon St. Gate F 9:28 Winds & Battery enter Indoor Warmup (Area A) Wind staff help move props down the 9:38 tunnel. 9:56 Color Guard vacate Indoor Warmup

Immediately following performance, Front Ensemble should exit the field into the Side 1 Tunnel (where we entered). Make sure all instruments, props and equipment are moved into the tunnel/end zone area, then return to the Side 1 end zone for Awards. Mallet instruments etc. may be stored in the auxiliary tunnel (to the right of the main tunnel as you leave the field) until after Awards. Drum Majors should report to the tunnel for Awards. Staff, please help move props all the way up the tunnel after students move props into the tunnel area.

#### **Tickets**

Tickets are available at both Gate A and Gate G. Ticket booths will be open at 7:00 a.m. Spectators may enter through Gates A or G, which will open at 7:15 a.m. Ticket prices are: Adults \$28; Students and Senior Citizens \$25; Children under 5: Free. Reentry is with ticket stub and hand stamp only.

**Ford Field is a cashless facility.** If you are purchasing tickets or concessions on site, you will need to use a credit or debit card. However, **programs, patches and MCBA apparel** are available for purchase with cash or credit.

#### Parking/Directions/More Information

Ford Field Parking Deck will cost \$6.00. It is located on St. Antoine St. across from Gate G of Ford Field. (This is most likely your cheapest and closest option!) Ford Field Parking Lots #4 & 5 will also be available for use. Other parking facilities nearest to Ford Field/Comerica Park will cost more; parking farther away from these areas may cost less. *The People Mover* runs in a loop around Detroit and has many stations near parking facilities.
